We have scheduled the above opportunities for you to satisfy your required four (4) hours of maintenance work while getting the pool ready for opening day. Please mark your calendars and plan on participating in one or both of these work parties. These are “**Rain or Shine**” work parties, so join us with your: painting supplies, shovels, pruners, brooms, rain gear, tool kits, rags mops, etc. **Because of safety and liability, NO children under 14 are allowed on the premises during work parties.** Remember: volunteer hours for swim/dive/tennis teams are NOT regarded as maintenance hours. In addition, those memberships not fulfilling this requirement will be assessed \$75.00 due by September 30, 2001. **Other maintenance opportunities are available throughout the summer season, but only after pre-arrangement and approval by the Board President or Vice President**

Club Apparel: It’s time once again to think about outfitting your swimmers and divers. Last year a new design for our swim/diving teams was selected for the 2000 and 2001 seasons. For any new team members or anyone needing different sizes, they will be available at our purchasing/fitting day at the pool, which will be scheduled in **June**, in conjunction with the Parent Information Night. There are Gregory Seahurst tee shirts and sweatshirts available in the Snack Shack for sale again this year.

Dates to remember:

Spring Work Parties – May 6 and May 12, 10 am to 4 pm - Please remember that because of safety and liability, NO children under 14 are allowed on the premises during work parties.

Pool Opens - Saturday, May 19th 12:00 P.M. Pool sponsored barbeque – hot dogs, chips and pop

Teen Party - Saturday, June 9th - This party is for teens in the 5th, 6th, and 7th grades in the 2000-2001 school year. Watch for more details about this fun party in the next newsletter.

Adult Party - Saturday, July 28th - We are planning to make some changes to this party this year and will be asking members for their input in the next newsletter.

Awards Banquet for the Swimming, Tennis and Diving Teams will be held early August, after the Seasons conclude.

Watch for the next newsletter. It will contain other important dates for all members – including swim and dive meets, tennis matches.

The annual dues this year have increased to \$350.00 and there is a \$75.00 assessment for all members for the 2001 year. The assessment is for the following:

\$5,500 for a pump room automated controller, which allows for offsite monitoring of water.

\$4,625 for deck caulking, storage shed door, and other pump room maintenance

\$1,500 for an additional section of aluminum bleachers

\$3,300 for parking lot sealing, striping

\$3,000 for electrical improvement to snack shack and facility lighting

(If any of these items are not completed in the coming year, the prorated assessment will be credited to the members.)

Just a reminder that in order to use the pool and tennis facilities, annual dues need to be paid on or before **May 15th, 2001**. Your statement for 2001 is included with this newsletter mailing. In addition, all fees from the past season, including maintenance, must be paid prior to using the pool this year.

Finally, the approved 2001 budget is attached. We'll see you all May 6th at the work party!
