These are “**Rain or Shine**” work parties, so join us with your: painting supplies, shovels, pruners, brooms, rain gear, tool kits, rags mops, etc. **Because of safety and liability, NO children under 14 are allowed on the premises during work parties.** Remember: volunteer hours for swim/dive/tennis teams are NOT regarded as maintenance hours. In addition, those memberships not fulfilling this requirement will be assessed \$75.00 due by September 30, 2002. **Other maintenance opportunities are available throughout the summer season, but only after pre-arrangement and approval by the Board President or Vice President**

Opening Day: The pool will open on Saturday, May 18, 2002 at 12:00 P.M. There will be a Pool sponsored barbeque – hot dogs, chips and pop from 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Club Apparel: It’s time once again to think about outfitting your swimmers and divers. This year a new design for our swim/diving, teams will be selected for the 2002 and 2003 seasons. Gregory Seahurst tee shirts and sweatshirts are available in the Snack Shack for sale again this year.
