Greetings!

We are looking forward to another terrific year with Opening Day set for May 17th at noon. There will be a club sponsored BBQ - hot dogs, chips and sodas from Noon until 2:00 p.m. Now is your chance to help make the pool and tennis grounds a place to be proud of. The "all member" work parties are on Sunday, May 4th and Saturday May 10th. The times for both days are 10am to 4pm. We have scheduled the dates for you to satisfy your family's required four (4) hours of maintenance work while getting the pool ready for opening day. These are "Rain or Shine" work parties, so join us with your painting supplies, shovels, pruners, brooms, rain gear, tool kits, rakes, weed whackers, wheel borrows, hand gardening tools, rags, mops, pick-up truck etc. Be sure to sign-in when you arrive and sign-out when you leave so we have a record of your time. **Because of safety and liability, no children under 14 are allowed on the premises during work parties.** Remember: **Volunteer hours for swim/dive/tennis teams are NOT regarded as maintenance hours.** Those memberships not fulfilling this requirement will be assessed \$75.00 due by September 30, 2003. Other maintenance opportunities are available throughout the summer season, but only after pre-arrangement and approval by the Board President or Vice President.

Job Applications – Deadline is March 31st, 2003. Any previous club employee must re-apply if they are interested in employment this summer. Written letters/resumes are required for all prospective employees. Applications not received by the March 31st deadline may not be considered due to time constraints. All lifeguards must submit a copy of their most current CPR, first aid, and lifeguard training cards in order to be considered. Events to Remember:

Work Parties – are on Sunday, May 4th and Saturday May 10th. The times for both days are 10 am to 4 pm.

Opening Day - Saturday, May 17th. Pool opens at noon for an all-day general swim. Hot dogs, chips and pop will be served from Noon 'till 2:00PM

Swimsuit fitting/ purchasing is on May 1st, 6:30PM at the pool. Parent meeting will be held at a later date still to be scheduled. The team suit for swim and dive will be the same this summer as last summer. – the Nike Adriatic. If your child needs a new suit this year, you may order it in any of the following ways:

1. Go to Pacific Bay Swim and Sport, try on sample suit and order there.
2. Order online from your home at www.pacbayswim.com.
3. Wait for the swimsuit fitting scheduled for May 1st, 6:30PM at the pool.

It is important to get your suit(s) ordered as soon as possible to ensure it arrives before the season starts. If you wait until after May 1st, we cannot guarantee your suit will arrive before the first meet, or even come at all. This is controlled by the manufacturer's production schedule and the quantities they produce. Teams in the warmer states have earlier seasons and therefore order their suits earlier in the year, and by the time our orders get placed, they don't have many suits left.

A list of non-paid memberships will be posted at the pool and admission will be denied until paid. Memberships, not paid by May 15th, 2003, are subject to forfeiture per Bylaw 6.4.01.
