Events to Remember:

- ◇ Work Parties – are on Sunday, May 1st and Saturday May 7th. The times for both days are 10 am to 4 pm.
- ◇ Opening Day - Saturday, May 14. Pool opens at noon for an all-day general swim. Hot dogs, chips and pop will be served from Noon 'till 2:00PM.
- ◇ Swimsuit fitting & ordering—May 18th at the pool, 5PM—7PM.
- ◇ Team Parent meeting - Tuesday, May 31, 6:30 PM at the pool. This meeting is for all teams – swim, dive & tennis. Team fees are \$55.00 per team/per child, and *must be paid on or before Monday, June 13th*. We would like to ask all parents whose children are interested in participating in this year's swim, dive or tennis teams to come meet the coaches and listen to their goals and ideas for this year. This is the best opportunity for new and returning parents to ask questions and reacquaint themselves with the team's routines. We will have available a Parent Information Packet, which will include medical authorization forms, directions to the event locations, practice schedules, etc. As always, your level of participation in your children's activities will determine the degree of success of our programs.
- ◇ Teen Party - Saturday, June 4^h, 6-10 pm - This party (rain or shine) is open to children currently in 6th, 7th, and 8th grades. Chaperones are needed any one interested please call Susie Gee (242-9297)
- ◇ Swim Team workouts – begin May 31st (see schedule for times).
- ◇ Dive Team practices begin June 20th - times to be announced.
- ◇ Tennis Team practices begin June 20th - times to be announced.

Emergency Notification Contact Sheets were included with your statement and are available on our web site. No member will be allowed to use the pool without this completed form on file in the office.

Water Safety Checks - All children under age 10 will be required to take a swim test to evaluate their safety level. Children must pass the swim test if they are not accompanied by a responsible adult or babysitter. All children age 8 and under must be accompanied at all times, even if they have passed their Water Safety Check. Check in with the lifeguard on duty for your pool test. The test will include 1 lap of freestyle (without holding onto the wall), 3 min of treading water and 1 minute of back floating.

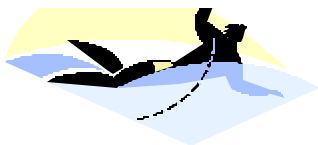
Alcoholic Beverages: A reminder that our Club Rules state that the consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed only with the permission of the board (and not an individual board member). Many members have expressed an interest in having an alcohol free club so this rule provides a process for gaining approval. Each time you plan to consume alcohol at the pool, please submit a request to the Pool Board President for consideration. You will receive a written response with the Board's requirements for responsible consumption of alcohol on the premises. The schedule for the monthly board meetings can be found in this newsletter.

House Guest Passes - Our bylaws state that a membership is assigned to one household. When a divorce occurs, the membership can only belong to one party. In order to allow the parent without the membership access to the pool, the board has expanded the use of the house guest pass for this purpose. The house guest pass can only be used when accompanied by a member (adult or child), and cannot be used to bring additional guests. If you have questions on whether or not the House Guest Pass is applicable to your situation, please contact Larry Wu.

Guest Passes – are required for all non-members, for tennis court use as well as the pool.

Annual Dues – In order to use the pool and tennis facilities, annual dues must be paid on or before May 14, 2005. Invoices were mailed in March.. A list of non-paid memberships will be posted at the pool and admission will be denied until paid. Memberships, not paid by May 14th, 2005, are subject to forfeiture per Bylaw 6.4.01.

Team Fees – Seattle Summer Swim League rules state that all required fees (membership, maintenance and delinquent fees) be paid, and your membership be in "good standing" prior to the first meet, or your child will not be eligible to participate. Our pool has the same requirements for tennis & dive. **Children will not be allowed at any practices after June 13th if all fees are not paid.**

Swimsuit Fitting – If you miss the swim suit fitting on May 18th, you may still purchase suits in the following ways:

1. Go to Pacific Bay Swim and Sport, try on a sample and order there.
2. Order online at www.pacbayswim.com.

Picnic Tables - Due to popular demand, some picnic tables and barbeques will be available by reservation – check in the pool office for details.

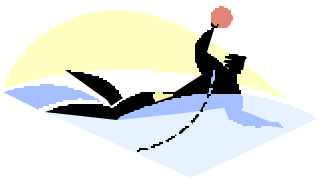

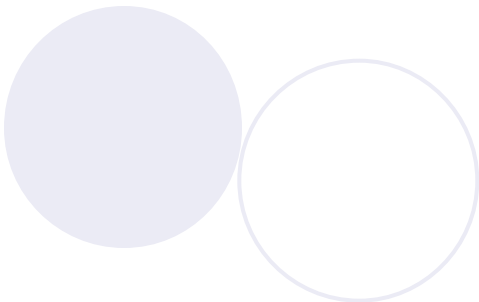
