These work parties give you an opportunity to fulfill your family's required four (4) hours of maintenance work, and provide the much needed manpower to get the pool ready for opening day. Other maintenance opportunities are available throughout the summer season, but must be arranged with Marc, and there will be one work party at the end of the season. Those members not fulfilling this requirement will be assessed \$75.00, due by September 30, 2008. You can elect to pay the \$75.00 now if you know you won't be doing any maintenance work this year.

Because of safety and liability issues, no children under 14 are allowed on the premises during work parties.

Swim and Dive Team

The swim and dive team selects new team suits every two years. This is one of those years. The team suit for the next two years will be the green and navy Radiance by Speedo for the girl's suit and for the boy's jammer. For boys that prefer the brief style suit, we will be ordering the Speedo Axcel Team Splice (there is no "brief" option with the Radiance) we will be buying our suits through Competitive Edge Athletics in Burien. Competitive Edge has recently moved to 14443 Ambaum Blvd. SW (next to Huckleberry Square Restaurant), (206) 246-7211. All orders made between April 1 and April 19 will be guaranteed to be available for the first dual meet of the season. Orders will also be accepted after April 19, but there are no guarantees on when they will arrive. Stop by the store for suit fittings any time starting April 1. All swim and dive team members are strongly encouraged to purchase a team suit. Competitive Edge is able to offer a very competitive team discount price of \$45-\$50 for the girl's suit and \$30-\$35 for the boy's suit.
